

#### **VPN - OS X Edition**

Connecting to the UMass Lowell VPN requires the use of 'Pulse Secure', a software package which you must load onto your OS X computer before you can connect to the VPN.

#### **Installing Pulse Secure on OS X:**

1. Open up a web browser and navigate to <a href="https://vpn.uml.edu">https://vpn.uml.edu</a>. Once connected to the site, enter your UML email address and password to continue.

In the "Files" section, click the link for JunOS Pulse Installers.




- 2. Click the *Installers* link, which will open the folder with all of the installers. Click on the PulseSecure\_Mac.dmg installer to download it to your machine.
- 3. Log out of the vpn.uml.edu website by choosing 'Sign Out' in the top right corner of the website.
- 4. Locate the DMG file just downloaded (most likely in the Downloads folder), then double click it.

5. This will open another window with the installer package inside.



6. To run this installer, right-click on the file and select **open**. If you do **not** right-click the file to open it you will get the following error:



7. When the installation runs, click "Continue" from the first screen and follow the prompts.


8. If asked for your credentials, please fill them in and click the "Install Software" button.



9. When the install has completed, you will see the "install was successful" screen. Close the window.



#### **Using Secure Pulse on a Mac:**

- 1. Open Pulse either by:
  - a. Opening the program by browsing for it under the Applications section of the Finder Or,
  - b. By clicking on the Pulse icon in the upper right-hand side of the desktop screen and select "Open Junos Pulse" from the menu.







2. When the Pulse window appears, click on the "+" button at the bottom-left of the screen.




3. Fill in a name and URL for the server.

4. You will now have an entry in the Pulse window for the VPN. Click "Connect".



5. When prompted, enter your UML credentials.



6. Once successfully connected the Pulse screen will look like this:



- 7. At this point you are connected to the UML Network and can continue to access file shares or applications as you normally would when using VPN.
- 8. You can minimize or close the PulseSecure window, this will not disconnect you from the VPN.
- 9. To disconnect from the VPN session, open up the PulseSecure application and click the Disconnect button.
